WHAT IS LIBRARY SEARCH?

Use **Library Search Catalogue** to find books, journals, theses and multimedia (images, audio and video, etc.) Many items are electronic.

Use **Library Search Articles** as one way to find some articles. It includes millions of articles from journals and news sources, and all the material in the Catalogue.

NOTE: Many more relevant articles on Education Faculty topics can be found in Library **Databases**.

Use **Library Search Readings and Exams** to find past exam papers.

NOTE: Education Faculty **readings** are usually best accessed elsewhere. Please consult your course outline or lecturer to find out the best way to access your course readings.

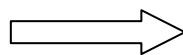
ACCESS LIBRARY SEARCH

SIGN IN TO LIBRARY SEARCH

To get the most out of **Library Search**, we recommend that you sign in, on the far right of the screen.

Click on **Sign In** and log in with NetID if prompted. Your status will change from **Guest** to your name.

REFINE YOUR RESULTS

To focus the search results according to your needs, use **Refine My Results** on the left-hand side of the screen.

In **Refine My Results**, choose a refinement. e.g. narrow your search to **Epsom Library**.

To find exact locations for **all** copies, and call numbers for hard-copy versions, click **Locations**. Click on the **plus sign** beside the name of the Library. Check that the status is **Available**.

Note the **library** (in this case Epsom Library), the **location** within the library (MAO means the item is shelved in the Maori collection), and the **call number**.

USEFUL LOCATION CODES

Location will first indicate the Library where the item is held e.g. Epsom or General, and may be followed by **one, or a combination**, of the following - which specify the precise location of the item in the library.

e.g. **EPSOM Mao, EPSOM Young Adult Fiction, EPSOM Pac Pictures, General NZ & Pacific**

FIND A BOOK TITLE

Using the **Catalogue** tab, type in the book title

e.g. Carpenter, V.M., Jesson, J., Roberts, P., & Stephenson, M. (Eds.). (2008). *Ngā kaupapa here: Connections and contradictions in education*. South Melbourne, Australia: Cengage Learning.

Hint: if you are using an APA reference list, the book title will usually be in italics.

Hint: for more precise searching put quote marks around the title. e.g. "nga kaupapa here"

FIND AN AUTHOR

Using the **Catalogue** tab, type in the **author's family name** and first name **or** initial

eg hattie j or hattie john

FIND A CHAPTER IN A BOOK

Using the **Catalogue** tab, type in the **book title** (not the chapter title, as only some chapter titles are listed in the Catalogue.)

e.g. Galanes, G.J. & Adams, K. (2007). Perspective on leadership in small groups. In *Effective group discussion* (pp.241-270). New York, NY: McGraw-Hill.

Hint: if you are using an APA reference list, the book title will usually be in italics.

Hint: for more precise searching put quote marks around the title. e.g. "effective group discussion"

Locate the book and then **find the chapter** using information from the reference, i.e. chapter title and page numbers.

FIND A JOURNAL

Using the **Catalogue** tab, enter the journal title. Adding quote marks will get a more precise result.

Hint: if you are using an APA reference list, the journal title will usually be in italics.



If your search returns too many results, use [Refine My Results](#) and choose **Journals** (under the Format heading).

FIND A SPECIFIC ARTICLE

e.g. [Trevithick, P. \(2007\). Revisiting the knowledge base of social work: A framework for practice. *British Journal of Social Work*, 38\(6\), 1212-1237.](#)

First search for the **journal title** (as above). Journals may be print and/or electronic
In **Locations**, see what issues the Library has and where. If an end date is absent, issues continue until the present.

FIND EXAM PAPERS

Using the **Readings & Exams** tab, type in your course code, either from the University Calendar or from the list provided when you first open the tab.







REQUEST OR RECALL MATERIAL

If you need a book which is on loan or located at another University of Auckland library, use the **Request** tab. Log in with your NetID if prompted.

Recall means the book is on loan and we will ask the borrower to return it.

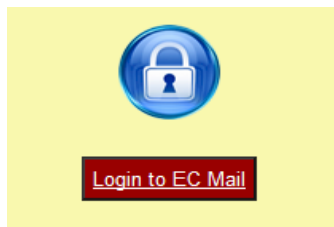
Select a copy from drop-down menu.

e.g. Epsom Library, Tai Tokerau Library


Use your **Library Account** (below) to check on the **status of your requests**. You will be emailed when items arrive.

NOTE: Library notifications go to your University email address. Check daily for important information.



Intercampus means the item is held at another library and we will arrange for it to be sent to Epsom (or Tai Tokerau) Library for you.

If requesting an article, click the **Article/Chapter** button, and enter the details.




- ➔ You **cannot** request items available on the same **campus** or library as your pickup location .
