Talis to RefWorks

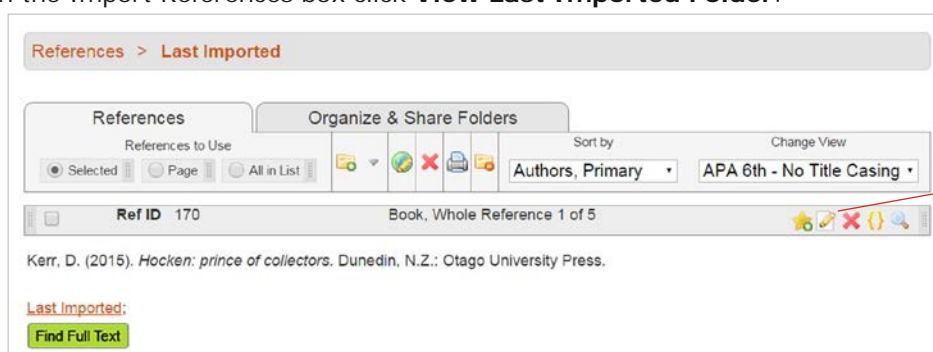
Exporting references from Talis to RefWorks allows you to edit references and create a bibliography formatted to your chosen reference style.

In Talis - <http://course-resources.auckland.ac.nz>

1. Go to **My Bookmarks**.
2. Select the resources you would like to export to RefWorks.
3. Click the **Export** button and then **Export to RefWorks** option.
This will automatically force RefWorks to open in a new tab.

In RefWorks

If you are not already logged in to RefWorks you will need to do so at this stage.
In the Import References box click **View Last Imported Folder**.



Check that your references are correct. If not, you can edit them by clicking on the pencil icon above each reference.

Creating a bibliography

1. Select the references to include in your bibliography.
2. Click **Create Bibliography**.
3. Select an output style.
4. Select a file type, eg, Word for Windows.
5. Click **Create Bibliography**.
You may get a prompt to download, save or open a file.



In Word

Open the bibliography in Word and check your reference list.

If any changes are required edit the records in RefWorks and recreate the bibliography. This ensures the changes are made for any future use of the records.
