Includes census of Ngatirangi adult males, 1864, and whakapapa tables.

Te Whanau-ā-Apanui is made up of 13 hapu in the Eastern Bay of Plenty, with established marae, details of which are given. Includes whakapapa tables.

Ancestral history which embraces eight waka that carried tribes to the Bay of Plenty. Contains many whakapapa tables.
