Adkin, L. *Horowhenua: Its Māori place-names and their topographic & historical background*. 1986.
A useful aid to whakapapa research, contains some whakapapa tables and area maps.

Carkeek, W. *The Kapiti coast: Maori History and Place Names*. 1966.
Māori tribal history and place names of the Paekakariki-Otaki district. Muaupoko Iwi, Ngati Rangī, Ngati Ira, Ngati Toa. Contains some whakapapa tables.

Ehrhardt, P. *Te Whanganui-ā-Tara: customary tenure 1750-1850*. 1993.
Te Whanganui-ā-Tara (Port Nicholson: Wellington harbour). Migration to this district was generally from the East and the people of the region had kin links to the East, West and South. Ngati Ira, Ngati Toa, Te Ati Awa.
