

Wireless network instructions

Connecting to the UoA-WiFi network – Generic

Note: This guide is a list of generic settings for devices connecting to UoA-WiFi using in-built wireless configuration service.

Connecting to UoA-WiFi

Ensure that your wireless settings are as follows:

Network Name (SSID)	UoA-WiFi
Security Type	WPA2-Enterprise or WPA2 with AES
Network Authentication Method	PEAP
Authentication Method	EAP-MSCHAPv2
Userid	Username
Security certificate	QuoVadis CA2 G3 Root Certificate
Server certificate	securewifi.auckland.ac.nz

Note: For most machines the setup process will be automatic, Windows XP being the exception.

Browsing the internet

When your device has connected to the UoA-WiFi network, you should be able to browse the internet.

Troubleshooting

If your device doesn't connect automatically to UoA-WiFi you can manually install the security certificate as follows:
